### WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

Students who are interested in a trade pathway and want to develop enterprise and employability skills to participate in a modern workplace while gaining skills in the civil construction industry.

To be eligible for selection students must be able to commit to training dates and have a learner's permit or provisional driver's licence.

### WHAT YOU CAN ACHIEVE

#### UP TO 20 STAGE ONE SACE CREDITS

Nationally accredited units form part of the Certificate III in Civil Construction (RII30920) qualification, designed to attract up to 20 SACE Stage One credits and to set students up for post school success. Students will receive a Statement of Attainment for units of competency achieved including:

- ▶ CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)
- ▶ RIIBEF201E Plan and organise work
- ▶ RIICCM205F Carry out manual excavation
- ▶ RIICCM207E Spread and compact materials manually
- ▶ RIISAM203E Use hand and power tools
- ▶ RIILWS201E Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures.

#### APPRENTICESHIPS

All students who successfully complete the Roads2Civil project will be considered for a Civil Apprenticeship.



#### PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE

Students will benefit from 'hands on' training at one of Civil Train's live training sites.

Suitable students will also have access to work experience placements through Renewal SA's Works Program.

#### WHAT'S INCLUDED

Students will be provided with all personal protective equipment (PPE) required to participate safely.

#### WHEN AND WHERE

Students will complete 4 weeks of training between **27 June and 22 July 2022** at one of Civil Train's live training sites and a project site within the Western suburbs.

#### COST

\$350 per student. If you are experiencing financial hardship please raise this in your application.

#### HOW TO APPLY

Interested students must register to attend a mandatory information session at **Civil Train, 1 South Road Thebarton** where you will meet the participating organisations and learn more about the program.
